Pipeline Project Cost Estimates: No. 24-0011

- Elizabeth instructed DKG to create cost estimate for the three pipeline projects in design. Tangelo Ave, San Tan Blvd, and Valencia Ave
- Tangelo Ave 1,975 LF Estimated Total \$ 427,912 (\$/LF \$ 216.66)
- San Tan Blvd 1,089 LF Estimated Total \$ 289,286 (\$/LF \$ 265.64)
- Valencia Ave 2,625 LF Estimated Total \$ 573,938 (\$/LF \$ 218.64)
- Board and Alfonso looking at the cost and what project is the priority

CHCID PROJECTS

- Tangelo Water Line Project: P23115 Plans approved
- San Tan Water Line Project: 178th to Lemon: P23116 Internal review completed, next step is to submit to MCESD
- Pump Station Improvements: P23117 Received SRP redlines. Changes are required to the plans. Alfonso reviewed the SRP redlines. A bill of Materials was drafted and sent out to One Electrical Engineer requesting electrical cost estimating. Plans submitted to Alfonso and SRP for review.
- Valencia Water Line: P24111 60% complete
- Litigation Status We have made four settlement offers to Sevilla's and Le Resche but they have either not responded or rejected all offers. Awaiting the judge's decision
- ➤ Lead Survey letters to 137 customers All letters have been mailed out and a copy of the letter is in each customer's file
- ➤ New Well Site land acquisition Mr. Mike Norby No new information, the owner has not responded

➤ Car Wash water connection into the CHCID system on the east side of the property – Jeff Wimmer, John Reddell and Jeff Francis attended the meeting to speak to the board about where they will be connecting to the CHCID water supply.

New Business

- > CHCID cost for lead inspection and submission for water testing —The Board agreed to charge customers \$50 for water sampling. A kit can be picked up from the office if customers request for their water to be tested. A \$50 charge was also agreed on for having a CHCID employee go and check what kind of pipes customers have, We will check on the connection at our meter and one at their connection at the home.
- ➤ Meter request/ crossing out terms of service agreement The Request was denied due to crossing out terms of service, office staff has not heard back

Action Items

- > Elizabeth will email the car wash with the decision on whether or not they can view the water pump plans
- > Pam will contact the owner of Big O Tire to set up a meeting to schedule an 8" line extension
